Our primary goal at this age is to help children experience the fun and joy that leads to an early excitement about learning.

Preschoolers at FCS Will:

- Receive lots of care and personal attention (10:1 student-to-teacher ratio).
- Build early math and literacy skills through play and other activities.
- Develop large and fine motor skills through tactile learning.
- Practice leadership and community during regular chapels and be recognized individually with a chapel award.
- Make friends in our fun environment and form nurturing bonds with our caregivers and teachers.

As a Preschool Parent, You Can Expect:

- A Strong Emphasis on Safety: We conduct thorough background checks on all staff and volunteers, keep all exterior doors locked, and require visitors to bring ID and be checked in through our Raptor Security System.
- Flexible Schedule Options: Choose from half-day or full-day options at FCS. Our Before School and Extended Care offerings run from 6:30 a.m. until 6 p.m. for busy, working parents.

Middle School (Grades 6-8)



Middle school is about much more than simply preparing for high school, although we ensure our students are ready for those challenges! and since we keep our classes small, our teachers truly get

Middle School Opportunities

- Everyone is encouraged to develop their leadership skills through academic projects and age-appropriate service opportunities on campus and in our community.
- Since our middle and high school campuses are right next door to each other, younger students can have supervised mentoring with a Senior Buddy. This also helps them get to know the high school campus, which makes that transition easier.
- They can be part of the yearbook staff or get involved with clubs such as Fellowship of Christian Athletes, IMPACT, or book club. We also offer 12 sports teams at the middle school level. In addition, middle school electives include band, orchestra, choir, computer, art, and more.

How to Support Your Student

- Encourage them to be active instead of passive learners and model that by learning fun things together outside of school.
- Pray with your child and be vulnerable so they can see your faith in action.
- Help them participate in a range of school activities to discover their interests.
- Develop an organizational strategy with them that fits their needs and learning style
- Keep engaging them in conversations about what they are learning and what excites them.

On average, 98% of our graduates go directly to college and our seniors earn hundreds of thousands of dollars in scholarships each year. 
The High School Experience at FCS
