## What is the Virginia Education Improvement Tax-Credit Program?

- The Education Improvement Tax-Credit Program provides scholarships to qualified families to attend recognized non-public schools in VA.

## How is the VA Education Improvement Tax-Credit Program funded?

- Individuals and businesses that pay VA state income tax can contribute through an approved Scholarship Foundation like the Children's Tuition Fund of VA (CTF of VA) and receive a 65% tax credit.

## Who is eligible to receive funding through the VA Education Improvement Tax-Credit Program?

### Families must meet the income guidelines below for eligibility for the 2022-23 School Year

Family Size	Maximum Income
2	\$54,930
3	\$69,090
4	\$83,250
5	\$97,410
6	\$111,570
7	\$125,730
8	\$139,890
9	\$154,050
10	\$168,210

### Who is eligible to receive funding?

- All eligible students entering or currently in Kindergarten or First Grade.
- All students who did not reside in the Commonwealth of Virginia in the immediately preceding school year.
- Students who are entering grades 2-12 who are new to FCS this year and transferred from a public school last year.

## How can contributors and schools participate?


- Contributors request "Preauthorization" from the state, then make their approved contribution to CTF of VA along with their completed "Preauthorization Notice". Contact CTF of VA for assistance in this process.
- Schools can lead their families to apply for a scholarship through CTF of VA.
